Sub: Grant of **conditional permission** to the **Sanjeevani Ayurvedic Medical College, Village- Kudana Chak, Near Brijghat, District-Amroha, Uttar Pradesh** with **100 seats** in BAMS (UG) course under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2017-18 – reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's order no. R.12011/16/2015-EP (IM-1) dated 09.12.2016 related to admission matter for the year 2016-17 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2017-18.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 28-29.04.2017 and again visited on 01.06.2017 to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry (*a copy of the assessment report of the CCIM is enclosed*). On examining the same it was observed that the college is having shortcomings related to the teaching staff, higher faculties, part time teachers, specialist doctors, non-availability of beds, non-functional OPD/IPD, required number of equipment/ instruments, hospital staff, non-teaching staff, plant species in herbal garden etc. as per RMS, 2016. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 04.08.2017 to present the case and further 2nd Hearing was given on 22.09.2017 considering the representation dated 11.09.2017 of the college submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH.

3. On examination of the recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM, observations of the hearing Committee alongwith the submission made by the college on 04.08.2017 and 22.09.2017 and after considering the representation dated 07.10.2017 alongwith the notarized affidavits submitted by the Chairman, Shri Ganapati Charitable and Welfare Trust, Takshila Colony, Meerut Uttar Pradesh regarding availability of the eligible teachers, higher faculties, yoga teacher, Biostatistician, part time teachers/consultant of modern medicine staff, required number of equipments/instruments, required number of beds in the hospital, specialist doctors, paramedical and hospital staff, functional OPDs/IPD in the hospital, non-teaching staff, required number of books in library, availability of college council, website and biometric attendance system; availability of herbal garden with 250 species; required land of the college, teaching Pharmacy & Quality testing laboratory in the college in terms of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016”, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC) for the

UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017, it has been decided by the Competent Authority of Central Government to **grant of conditional permission** to the **Sanjeevani Ayurvedic Medical College, Village- Kudana Chak, Near Brijghat, District- Amroha, Uttar Pradesh with 100 seats** in BAMS (UG) course for the academic session 2017-18 under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject only to the condition that, apart from the above deficiencies, the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31st December, 2017 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2018-19 onwards:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 and 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016.
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

4. The fulfillment of the deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report of CCIM (if any) and conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2018-19.

5. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
